## **"Putting Sydney on Show" Competition Rules:**

- 1]** A category prize will only be awarded if there are 10 or pieces entered in the category - If there are less than 10 entries in a category those entries will be included in the General Woodworking category
- 2]** Competition entries must have been made after June 1, 2004 and must not have been entered into any other competition
- 3]** Entries may not be entered in more than one category except for the Open Novice category and the Young Achiever category
- 4]** Open Novice is restricted to those who have never won a prize or an award of any sort in woodwork competitions
- 5]** Individuals may enter up to 3 entries in the competition
- 6]** The Young Achiever category is open to all woodworkers under 20 years of age
- 7]** Entry Details must be lodged with the Timber & Working with Wood Show office by May 19<sup>th</sup> 2005 - details below
- 8]** Entries must be delivered to the competition area in the Hordern Pavilion between 3pm-6pm on Wednesday June 1<sup>st</sup> or 8am-10am on Thursday June 2<sup>nd</sup> - a receipt will be given on delivery
- 9]** Entries may be for sale but must remain on exhibition for the duration of the show
- 10]** Entries must be collected between 5pm-7pm Sunday June 5<sup>th</sup> - the delivery receipt must be shown
- 11]** The show management will take due care but not responsibility for damage, theft or loss. Entrants are encouraged to arrange insurance for their work
- 12]** It is the entrants' responsibility to arrange freight for their entry to and from the competition
- 13]** All entries to the "Putting Sydney on Show" competition must be displayed within the designated competition area except for the Young Achiever Award, which will be located separately but adjacent
- 14]** The Judges decision will be final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into
- 15]** A prize presentation evening will be held in the Hordern Pavilion Thursday June 2<sup>nd</sup> from 7pm-8:30pm
- 16]** Prize Pool to be confirmed by December 1<sup>st</sup> 2004
